

Tanker Reef spring surveys with CDFW

- 50% of control site was surveyed in March,
- remaining dives (control and the grid) being rescheduled

Sound mooring at SESA to characterize:


- La Cruz Canyon area

MBARI expedition

- ROV surveys at Davidson Seamount and Sur Ridge
 - O "Octopus Garden" (3200 m) time-lapse camera
 - Experimental respiration chambers for eggs
 - Sur Ridge DSC observatory
 - BBC acquired additional octopus footage about the octopus garden

New mooring for passive acoustic monitoring at La Cruz Canyon (SESA #15)

Emergency Responses in March/April

- 26 ft Sailing vessel adrift/sank of Natural Bridges State Beach;
- 19 ft power vessel capsized off Moss Landing;
- Foamy surfactant released into Monterey harbor

Spike in Whale Entanglements

• Whale entanglements spiked in March/April with 4 humpbacks and 1 gray whale; CDFW closed commercial Dungeness crab fishery for all zones by April 20

Special Emphasis Enforcement Patrols: April 2 - 3

• NOAA Office of Law Enforcement, CDFW, US Coast Guard and harbor patrols focused on MBNMS and GFNMS with approximately 30 personnel.

- → Condition Report workshops


